

Chain of Dogs Biography



If you ever wanted to find out what it would sound like if Slayer got into a fight with Flogging Molly on stage, after which they decide to patch things up with a bottle of vodka, you should listen to Chain of Dogs. Their energetic mix of folk, metal and punk is a guaranteed recipe for a party on and in front of the stage. Chain of Dogs are from the south of the Netherlands but they play all over Europe; they played at Metaldays 2014 in Slovenia and at many smaller festivals such as Black Troll Winterfest, Sodom Open Air and Occultfest. Chain of Dogs have toured with bands like Suidakra, Waylander and XIV Dark Centuries in addition to being a frequent support for bands like Heidevolk, Arkona, Skyforger and Finsterforst.

The latest Chain of Dogs release is a compilation CD called "Burning Bridges in a World of Death", released by Witches Brew in early 2014. This contains two EP's from 2008 and 2012 and various demo tracks as well as unreleased material. Chain of Dogs also released their first full-length, "Gebroake, Gehange en Gewroake on the Witches Brew label in 2010. A new vinyl EP and full length-cd are in the making.
